ble to transfer credits and join Deakin University for their 3rd year studies in Bachelor of Civil Engineering (Honours) - BCivEng(Hons) and Bachelor of Electrical and Electronic Engineering (Honours)- BElec&ElecEng(Hons). The two degree programmes are accredited by Engineers Australia.

Established in 1974, Deakin has a five star rating awarded by Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) and is ranked 36
