International Recognition for local four year full time engineering degrees and local engineers

The Institution of Engineers, Sri Lanka (IESL) is pleased to announce to the general public and the Higher Educational Institutions in Sri Lanka that the IESL is now a full signatory to the internationally accepted Washington Accord. This now enables Sri Lankan Engineering degrees accredited by the IESL to be internationally recognized.

The degrees of graduates of programs accredited by IESL and who pass out after June 13, 2014 will be recognized by all of the other signatories to the Washington Accord as being substantially equivalent to accredited or recognized qualifications within their own countries. The other signatories to the Accord are as given below:

The IESL is also a continuing member of the International Professional Engineers Agreement (IPEA) which is a multi-national agreement among several engineering organizations and which has established an international standard of competence for professional engineering practice. It empowers each member organization to maintain a national section of the International Professional Engineers Register. Registrants on these national sections can receive credit when seeking registration or licensure in the jurisdictions of other members thus facilitating cross border mobility of engineers.
